

francesco napolitano of italian architecture and design office LAD has shared photographs of 'the stealth', a realized shopping center and plaza in rome. shaped like a mastaba, a type us advertise

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sloping sides clad in titanium–zinc. the design echoes the natural slopes found in the region's terrain, establishing a synthesis between architecture and the environment. access inside the truncated pyramid is found behind panels which fold upwards from the building's façade, providing a sense of security and protection when not in use.



the building is shaped like a mastaba, a type of ancient egyptian tomb



the flat-roofed structure features outward sloping sides clad in titanium-zinc



access inside the truncated pyramid is found behind panels which fold upwards from the building's façade



a sheltered dining area



the design echoes the natural slopes found in the region's terrain



the project takes its name from military architecture and aerodynamics






